Your Governing Body

The Governing Body represents the local community in the running of the school. It is made up of parents, staff, people appointed by the local authority and people who are co-opted by the Governors themselves. Governors are mainly concerned with policy and strategy and the Headteacher and staff are accountable to the Governing Body.
