Introduction. The Friends of Ysgol Harri Tudur/ Henry Tudor School (The Friends) is a registered charity formed by parents, staff, extended families and friends of the school. The Friends raise money to help support the school and help bring the wider community together by organising social events throughout the year.

Benefits and commitment. The Friends depend purely on volunteers; but there is no fixed commitment and individuals can do as much or as little as they wish; 'every little helps'! The Friends aim to assist the school primarily through fund raising. Such funds help provide school equipment and resources, offset trips and support learner bursaries. The Friends provide grants to assist with after school clubs, extracurricular activities and well-being projects.

Fund raising. The Friends main funding raising events are the annual school summer fete (held in late June, although one will not be held in June 2025), providing refreshments for open evenings and other events such as school concerts, and running raffles. The Friends also run the School Shop which offers a selection of new and second hand uniform and other school related items. The Shop is open every Wednesday from 3.30 to 4.30 pm and can be made available at other times by request (via emailing contact@yht.wales).

Meetings. The Friends meet at least twice a term; on a Tuesday from 5.30 pm. Dates are published in advance. An online means can be arranged if requested.
